Information for orchestra players

Directions and general logistics	<p>The orchestra will be performing on Stage 1 on the Carnival Field aka the Mundy Playing Fields. Please see maps below for access points. There's also an interactive map of Thornbury here: http://www.mythornbury.co.uk/map</p> <p>Please note that there will be official road blocks in the morning in preparation for the Carnival parade which will seal off entry to some of the town centre car parks. Other central car parks are likely to fill up very early. There is no public access to the carnival field via Kington Lane.</p> <p>The Carnival Association recommends that Thornbury residents leave their cars at home. Otherwise, please use the official Carnival car park at Thornbury Leisure Centre.</p>
Meeting at Thornbury Leisure Centre, Alveston Hill, BS35 3JB	<p>11.30 As the streets are likely to be very crowded, we will meet outside the Leisure Centre foyer and walk to the Carnival field as a group (5 – 10 minute walk).</p>
Meeting at Stage 1 on Mundy Playing Fields to set up	<p>11.45 If you are planning to watch the parade and it is not sensible to meet us at the Leisure Centre, please meet us at Stage 1 at this time. Bear in mind that the gates onto the field can get very congested so allow extra time.</p>
Performance	<p>12.20 – 12.50 Chansons (2) Dam Busters Calling All Workers RVW Kitchen (TBC) Curzon</p>
Dress code	Black trousers/skirt + non-patterned, bright, single-colour top/shirt
To bring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Music stand • Pegs • Performers' pass – this will give you free and priority access to the Carnival Field (and before the gates officially open). These will be handed out at the final rehearsal on Wednesday 30 June and at the Leisure Centre on Saturday 3 July.

Despite all the logistical difficulties, Thornbury Carnival is a great community event. I hope you enjoy being part of it!

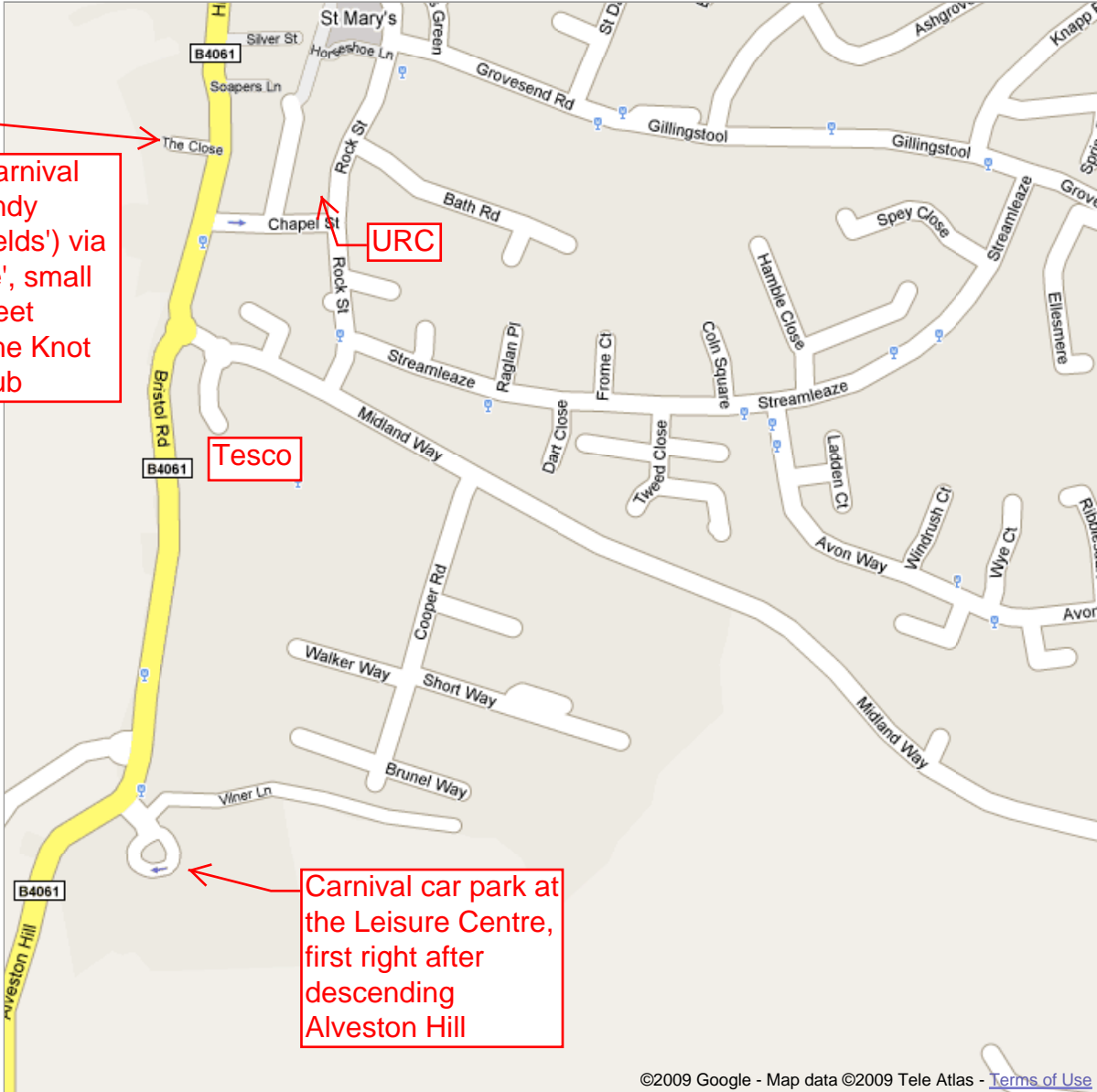

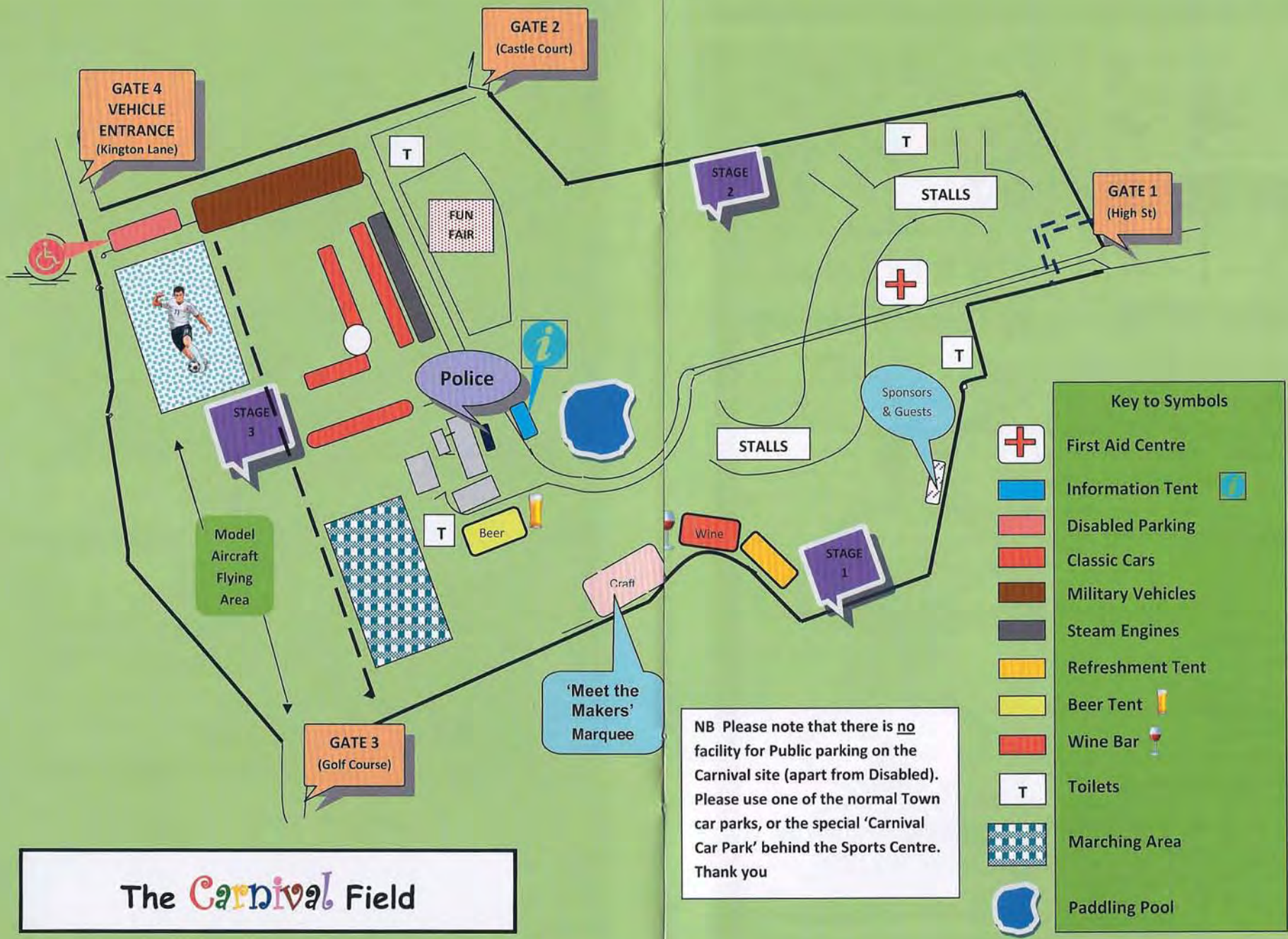
